Sample Schedule for 2-week unit on digital mapping in the humanities

This schedule assumes a 3-day-a-week class. Boldfaced items are available in the <u>dla101.org</u> resources.

Day 1

Reading: visit the **example of a simple story map**. In class: **First Exercise** Distribute **Easy story map assignment** for Day 4

Day 2

Reading: View **discipline specific examples** online. [reading in course content can continue]

In class: Discuss discipline specific examples and the spatial or geographical elements of the course content. [see **Story maps in different areas** in resources]

Day 3

Reading: The Five Principles of Effective Storytelling (online) Sample Web Map version of material from First Exercise (online) [reading in course content can continue] In class: Second exercise (choose either option A and B)

Distribute: Advanced Map Assignment

Day 4

Reading: none?

Present a selection of student projects in simple story mapping. Discuss and comment, with an aim of eliciting possibilities opened up by more complex mapping.

Day 5

Reading: [reading in course content can continue] In class: Continuing discussion/lecture on course content. Reserve at least 1/2 hour to go over students' questions and concerns about their projects.

Day 6

Reading: *[reading in course content can continue]* Present a selection of student projects in advanced web mapping. Discuss and comment.



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
